Sermon: While you wait

1. Share What are some of your strengths and one of your weaknesses?

2. Activity Secret Dancer. You might need some music for this. Set up the group to stand in a circle, and choose one player to be the detective. Send the detective outside.

When the detective has left the room, choose a player to be the "secret dancer". They will need to pick a dance move and everyone will then start copying them.

When everyone is dancing, the detective is called back into the room and has three guesses to choose who the original dancer is.

To make things interesting, the secret dancer then needs to change dance move, and everyone needs to change with them. This allows the detective to discover the secret dancer.

4. Digging Deeper:

~ A popular quote goes like this: *"God doesn't call the qualified, He qualifies the called!"* But it seems like with Moses, God waited until he was disqualified... 40 years is enough to forget the military training, the book-smarts and the language.

~ In your opinion what was it that God worked on in Moses while the 40 year preparation?

~ What has God been working out in you? Or what is He trying to work on right now?

~ Can you think of a situation you didn't wait for God's timing, what was the outcome; Or the situation in which you waited for God, what was the outcome then?

~ Pastor Alex said that often God lets us practice with little, before He gives us an important assignment. *Luke 16:10 TPT 10 "The one who manages the little he has been given with faithfulness and integrity will be promoted and trusted with greater responsibilities. But those who cheat with the little they have been given will not be considered trustworthy to receive more."*

~ How does this scripture apply to your life or the lives of people you know/observe?

5. Taking it home:

Pastor talked about the concept of filling your life with joy by celebrating other's. You know, celebrate with friends their wins, promotions, successes, blessings, etc. If you are very honest is this something that comes easy to you? Or do you get jealous and bitter? Ask God to teach you how to live a life to the fullest.
